Medicaid Disclosure Form and Requirements

Federal regulations require Medicaid providers to disclose certain ownership and business transaction information. As a result, NIA's network providers **must complete a Medicaid Disclosure Form** as part of the credentialing, recredentialing and ongoing Network monitoring requirements.

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Medicaid Disclosure Form and Requirements *(continued)*

NIA created a **Form** to comply with the Medicaid disclosure requirements pursuant to 42 CFR 455.104, 105, and 106. These federal regulations require Medicaid providers to disclose information regarding (1) the identity of all individuals and entities with an ownership or control interest of 5% or greater in the provider, including the identity of managing employees and agents; (2) certain business transactions between the provider and subcontractors/wholly owned suppliers; (3) the identity of any individual or entity with an ownership or control interest in the provider or disclosing entity, or who is an agent or managing employee of the provider or disclosing entity that has ever been convicted of any crime related to that person's involvement in any program under the Medicaid, Medicare, or other related programs.

Federal regulations require that this provider information be collected by the state Medicaid agency. As such, NIA is required to provide a report with all the information obtained through this disclosure to all of our Medicaid health plan customers. The report will be forwarded to the State Medicaid Agency by the respective Medicaid health plan. This report will also include the names of all providers that failed to complete and return the Form within the specified timeframe.

If you should receive a notification for Medicaid Disclosure Form completion, please take the time to review and complete the Form to ensure ongoing compliance with the Medicaid regulatory disclosure requirements. Failure to comply with the regulatory Medicaid disclosure requirements and Provider Contract Disclosure Provisions **may result** in sanctions from the state Medicaid program and/or termination of your Agreement with NIA respectively. **PLEASE NOTE: NO ACTION REQUIRED AT THIS TIME; YOU WILL RECEIVE A SEPARATE REQUEST AT A FUTURE DATE.**
