| What Medical Specialty         Solutions Services require         providers to obtain a prior         authorization?         When is prior authorization         required? | <ul> <li>The following non-emergent, outpatient, Medical Specialty Solutions services require prior authorization through Evolent:</li> <li>Effective January 1, 2014:</li> <li>CT/CTA</li> <li>CCTA</li> <li>MRI/MRA/MRS</li> <li>PET Scan</li> <li>Myocardial Perfusion Imaging</li> <li>Nuclear Medicine</li> <li>MUGA Scan</li> <li>Emergency room and inpatient procedures do not require prior authorization from Evolent. If an urgent/emergent clinical situation exists outside of a hospital emergency room, please contact Evolent immediately with the appropriate clinical information for an expedited review.</li> <li>Prior authorization is required for outpatient, non-emergent procedures. Ordering providers must obtain prior authorization of these procedures prior to the service being performed at an imaging facility.</li> </ul> |
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| Is prior authorization<br>necessary for sedation with<br>an MRI?   | No, prior authorization is not required for sedation when performed with an MRI.  |
| Is an Evolent authorization<br>number needed for a CT-<br>guided biopsy?   | No, prior authorization is not required for this procedure.   |
| Can a chiropractor order images?   | Yes.  |
| Are routine Imaging services a part of this program?   | No.   |
| Are inpatient advanced<br>imaging (MR/MRI, CT/CTA,<br>PET) procedures included in<br>this program?   | No. Inpatient advanced imaging procedures are not included in this program.   |
| Is prior authorization<br>required for Medical<br>Specialty Solutions Services<br>performed in the emergency<br>room?  | No. Medical Specialty Solutions Services<br>performed in the emergency room are not<br>included in this program and do not require prior<br>authorization through Evolent.  |

| How does the ordering<br>provider obtain a prior<br>authorization from Evolent<br>for a Medical Specialty<br>Solutions outpatient<br>service? | Providers can request prior authorization via the internet ( <u>RadMD.com</u> ) or by calling Evolent at 1-800-424-4908.  |
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| What information is required<br>to receive prior<br>authorization?  | <ul> <li>To expedite the prior authorization process, please refer to the specific required documentation for each Medical Specialty Solution. Have the appropriate information ready before logging into RadMD or calling Evolent's call center (*Information is required.)</li> <li>Name and office phone number of ordering provider*</li> <li>Member name and ID number*</li> <li>Requested examination*</li> <li>Name of provider office or facility where the service will be performed*</li> <li>Anticipated date of service</li> <li>Details justifying examination*</li> <li>Symptoms and their duration</li> <li>Physical exam findings</li> <li>Conservative treatment member has already completed (e.g., physical therapy, chiropractic or osteopathic manipulation, hot pads, massage, ice packs, medications)</li> <li>Preliminary procedures already completed (e.g., referrals to specialist, specialist evaluation)</li> <li>Reason the study is being requested (e.g., further evaluation, rule out a disorder)</li> </ul> |

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| Can a provider request more<br>than one service at a time for<br>a member?  | Evolent can handle multiple authorization requests<br>per contact. Separate authorization numbers are<br>issued by Evolent for each service that is<br>authorized.  |
| What kind of response time<br>can ordering providers<br>expect for prior<br>authorization?                          | Generally, within 2 business days after receipt of<br>request with full clinical documentation, a<br>determination will be made. In certain cases, the<br>review process can take longer if additional clinical<br>information is required to make a determination.   |
| What does the Evolent<br>authorization number look<br>like?   | The Evolent authorization number consists of<br>alpha- numeric characters. In some cases, the<br>ordering provider may receive an Evolent tracking<br>number (not the same as an authorization<br>number) if the provider's authorization request is<br>not approved at the time of initial contact.<br>Providers can use either number to track the<br>status of their request online or through an<br>Interactive Voice Response (IVR) telephone<br>system. |
| If requesting authorization<br>through RadMD and the<br>request pends, what happens<br>next?                        | You will receive a tracking number and Evolent will contact you to complete the process.  |
| Can RadMD be used to request an expedited authorization request?  | RadMD may only be used for expedited requests<br>that occur after normal business hours. Those<br>expedited requests that occur during normal<br>business hours must be called into Evolent's call<br>center for review and processing.   |
| What happens if a member is<br>authorized for a service and<br>the provider feels an<br>additional study is needed? | If the provider feels that, in addition to the service<br>already authorized, an additional service is<br>needed, please contact Evolent immediately with<br>the appropriate clinical information for an<br>expedited review.   |
| Can the rendering facility<br>obtain authorization in the<br>event of an urgent service?                            | Yes. If they initiate the process, Evolent will follow-up with the ordering provider to complete the process.   |
| How long is the prior<br>authorization number valid?  | The authorization number is valid for 90 days from<br>the date of decision. When a procedure is<br>authorized, Evolent uses the date of initial request<br>as the starting point for the 90-day period in which<br>the examination must be completed.   |

| Is prior authorization<br>necessary for a Medical<br>Specialty Solutions<br>outpatient service if Ambetter<br>from Arkansas Health &<br>Wellness is NOT the<br>member's primary<br>insurance? | No   |
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| If a provider obtains a prior<br>authorization number does<br>that guarantee payment?   | An authorization number is not a guarantee of<br>payment. Authorizations are based on medical<br>necessity and are contingent upon eligibility and<br>benefits. Benefits may be subject to limitations<br>and/or qualifications and will be determined when<br>the claim is received for processing. |
| Does Evolent allow retro-<br>authorizations?  | Yes. However, it is important that provider staff is familiar with the prior authorization requirements. Claims will not be reimbursed if they have <u>not</u> been properly authorized. The rendering facility <b>should not</b> schedule services without prior authorization.                     |
| Can a provider verify an authorization number online?   | Yes. Providers can check the status of member authorizations quickly and easily by going to the Evolent website at <u>RadMD.com</u> .  |
| Will the Evolent<br>authorization number be<br>displayed on the Ambetter<br>from Arkansas Health &<br>Wellness website?   | No.  |
| SCHEDULING SERVICES   | Evalent manages Medical Specialty Solutions  |
| How does Evolent determine<br>where to schedule Medical<br>Specialty Solutions Services<br>for Ambetter from Arkansas<br>Health & Wellness members?   | Evolent manages Medical Specialty Solutions<br>services through the Ambetter from Arkansas<br>Health & Wellness contractual relationships.   |

| Why does Evolent ask for a<br>date of service when<br>authorizing a procedure? Do<br>providers have to obtain an<br>authorization before the<br>services are rendered? | During the authorization process, Evolent asks<br>where the procedure is being performed and the<br>anticipated date of service. The exact date of<br>service is not required. Providers should obtain<br>authorization before scheduling the member.  |
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| WHICH MEDICAL PROVIDERS  | ARE AFFECTED?  |
| Which medical providers are<br>affected by the Medical<br>Specialty Solutions<br>program?  | <ul> <li>Any provider who orders Medical Specialty<br/>Solution Services in an outpatient setting.</li> <li>Ordering providers will need to request a prior<br/>authorization, and the delivering/servicing<br/>providers will need to ensure there is an<br/>authorization number to bill the service.</li> <li>Ordering providers, including Primary<br/>Care Providers (PCPs) and Specialty<br/>Care providers.</li> <li>Delivering/Servicing providers who<br/>perform Medical Specialty Solutions<br/>Services at: <ul> <li>Freestanding diagnostic facilities</li> <li>Ambulatory Surgical Centers</li> <li>Hospital outpatient diagnostic<br/>facilities</li> <li>Provider offices</li> </ul> </li> </ul> |
| CLAIMS RELATED<br>Where do providers send<br>their claims for Medical<br>Specialty Solutions<br>outpatient services?   | Providers should continue to send claims to the<br>address indicated on the back of the Ambetter<br>from Arkansas Health & Wellness member ID<br>card. Providers are also encouraged to follow their<br>normal EDI claims process.   |
| How can providers check claims status?   | Providers should check claims status on the Ambetter from Arkansas Health & Wellness claim website at: <u>http://www.ambetterofarkansas.com</u> .  |
| Who should a provider<br>contact if they want to appeal<br>a prior authorization or<br>claims payment denial?  | In the event of a prior authorization or claims<br>payment denial, providers may appeal the<br>decision through Ambetter from Arkansas Health<br>& Wellness. Providers should follow the<br>instructions on their non-authorization letter or<br>Explanation of Payment (EOP) notification.  |

| MISCELLANEOUS  |  |
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| How is medical necessity defined?  | <ul> <li>Evolent defines medical necessity as a service that:</li> <li>Meets generally accepted standards of medical practice; is appropriate for the symptoms, consistent with diagnosis, and otherwise in accordance with sufficient evidence and professionally recognized standards;</li> <li>Is appropriate to the illness or injury for which it is performed as to type of service and expected outcome;</li> <li>Is appropriate to the intensity of service and level of setting;</li> <li>Provides unique, essential, and appropriate information when used for diagnostic purposes;</li> <li>Is the lowest cost alternative that effectively addresses and treats the medical problem; and rendered for the treatment or diagnosis of an injury or illness; and</li> <li>Is not furnished primarily for the convenience of the member, the attending provider, or other provider.</li> </ul> |
| Where can a provider find<br>NIA's Guidelines for Medical<br>Specialty Solutions<br>Services?  | Evolent's Clinical Guidelines can be found on<br>Evolent's website, <u>RadMD.com</u> under Online<br>Tools/Clinical Guidelines. Evolent's guidelines for<br>Medical Specialty Solutions Services have been<br>developed from practice experience, literature<br>reviews, specialty criteria sets and empirical data.   |
| Did the Ambetter from<br>Arkansas Health & Wellness<br>member ID card change with<br>the implementation of this<br>Medical Specialty Solutions<br>Program? | No. The Ambetter from Arkansas Health &<br>Wellness member ID card does not contain any<br>Evolent information on it and the member ID card<br>did not change with the implementation of this<br>Medical Specialty Solutions Program.  |
| What is an OCR Fax<br>Coversheet?  | By utilizing Optical Character Recognition (OCR) technology, Evolent can automatically attach incoming clinical faxes to the appropriate case in our clinical system. We strongly recommend that ordering providers print an OCR fax coversheet from <u>RadMD.com</u> or contact Evolent to obtain one. Evolent can fax this coversheet to the ordering  |

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|   | provider during authorization intake or at any time<br>during the review process. By prefacing clinical<br>faxes to Evolent with an OCR fax coversheet, the<br>ordering provider can ensure a timely and efficient<br>case review.  |
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| <b>RECONSIDERATION AND APP</b>  | EALS PROCESS  |
| Is the Reconsideration<br>process available for the<br>outpatient Medical Specialty<br>Solutions services once a<br>denial is received? | Once a denial determination has been made, if the<br>office has new or additional information to provide,<br>a reconsideration can be initiated by uploading via<br>RadMD or faxing (using the case specific fax<br>cover sheet) additional clinical information to<br>support the request. A reconsideration must be<br>initiated within 5 business days from the date of<br>denial and prior to submitting a formal appeal.   |
|   | Evolent has a specialized clinical team focused on<br>Medical Specialty Solutions services. Peer-to-peer<br>discussions are offered for any request that does<br>not meet medical necessity guidelines. Providers<br>can call the phone number(s) above to initiate the<br>peer-to-peer process. These discussions provide<br>an opportunity to discuss the case and collaborate<br>on the appropriate services for the member based<br>on the clinical information provided. |
| Who should a provider   | Providers are asked to please follow the appeal   |

| RADMD ACCESS  |   |
| What option should I select<br>to receive access to initiate<br>authorizations?   | Selecting " <b>Physician's office that orders</b><br><b>procedures</b> " will allow you access to initiate<br>authorization requests for outpatient exams and/or<br>specialty procedures.   |
| How do I apply for RadMD<br>access to initiate<br>authorization requests?   | <ul> <li>Prospective users should go to our website</li> <li><u>RadMD.com</u>.</li> <li>Click New User</li> <li>Choose "Physician's office that orders procedures" from the drop-down box</li> <li>Complete application with necessary information</li> <li>Click Submit</li> <li>Once an application is submitted, the user will receive an email from our RadMD support team</li> </ul>   |

|   | within a few hours after completing the application<br>with an approved username and a temporary<br>passcode. Please contact the RadMD Support<br>Team at 1-800-327-0641 if you do not receive a<br>response within 72 hours.  |
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| What is rendering provider access?  | <ul> <li>Rendering provider access allows users the ability to view all approved authorizations for their office or facility. If an office is interested in signing up for rendering access, you will need to designate an administrator through the account application process on RadMD.</li> <li>Click New User</li> <li>Choose "Facility/Office where procedures are performed" from the drop-down box</li> <li>Complete application with necessary information</li> <li>Click Submit</li> </ul> Examples of a rendering facility that only need to view approved authorizations: <ul> <li>Hospital facility</li> <li>Billing department</li> <li>Offsite location</li> <li>A user in another location who is not interested in initiating authorizations</li> </ul> |
| Which link on RadMD will I<br>select to initiate an<br>authorization request for an<br>outpatient exam or specialty<br>procedure? | Clicking the "Exam or specialty procedure<br>(including Cardiac, Ultrasound, Sleep<br>Assessment)" link will allow the user to submit a<br>request for an outpatient exam or specialty<br>procedure.   |
| How can providers check the status of an authorization request?   | Providers can check on the status of an authorization by clicking the "Search for Request" link on RadMD's main menu.  |
| How can I confirm what<br>clinical information has been<br>uploaded or faxed to<br>Evolent?                                       | Clinical Information that has been received via<br>upload or fax can be viewed by clicking the<br>member name via the "Search for Request" link<br>from the main menu. At the bottom of the "Exam<br>Request Verification: Detail" page, click "View" in<br>the "Documents Received" section and select the<br>appropriate link for the upload or fax.   |

| Where can providers find<br>their case-specific<br>communication from<br>Evolent?  | Links to case-specific communication to include<br>requests for additional information and<br>determination letters can be found via the "Search<br>for Request" link.   |
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| If I did not submit the initial<br>authorization request, how<br>can I view the status of a<br>case or upload clinical<br>documentation? | The "Track an Authorization" feature will allow<br>users who did not submit the original request to<br>view the status of an authorization, as well as<br>upload clinical information. This option is also<br>available as a part of your main menu options<br>using the "Search for Request" feature. A tracking<br>number is required to use this search method.   |
| Can I share my RadMD<br>access with my coworkers?  | Yes, through our "Shared Access" feature. This<br>process allows providers to view authorization<br>requests initiated by other RadMD users within<br>your practice. By sharing access with other users,<br>the user will be able to view and manage the<br>authorization requests that you initiated, allowing<br>them to communicate with your patients and<br>progress with treatment if you are not available. |
| Paperless Notification:<br>How can I receive<br>notifications electronically<br>instead of paper?  | Evolent defaults communications including final<br>authorization determinations to<br>paperless/electronic. Correspondence for each<br>case is sent to the email of the person submitting<br>the initial authorization request.  |
|  | Users will be sent an email when determinations are made.  |
|  | <ul> <li>No PHI will be contained in the email.</li> <li>The email will contain a link that requires the user to log into RadMD to view PHI.</li> </ul>  |
|  | Providers who prefer paper communication will be<br>given the option to opt out and receive  |
