



## Trillium Health Resources Medical Specialty Solutions Program Provider Education Webinars

In keeping with our commitment of promoting continuous quality improvement for services provided to Trillium Health Resources members, Trillium has entered into an agreement with Evolent (formerly National Imaging Associates, Inc. (NIA)), to implement a Medical Specialty Solutions program. This program includes prior authorization of non-emergent, advanced, outpatient imaging and cardiac services for Trillium members. The decision to implement this program is consistent with industry-wide efforts to ensure clinically appropriate quality of care and to manage the increasing utilization of these services.

Trillium Health Resources, consistent with NC Medicaid guidance, is waiving prior authorization for the dates of service from July 1, 2024, through January 31, 2025. Prior authorization is required for all dates of service February 1, 2025, and thereafter.

### **Medical Specialty Solutions Services (MSS):**

Services managed and authorized by Evolent include **outpatient CT/CTA, MRI/MRA, PET Scan, MUGA Scan, Nuclear Stress Test, Echocardiography.**
